

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please have your poster prepared in advance. It is strongly recommended that your poster is made of a material that can be held by the **pins** which will be available at the Poster Help Desk. All Posters have to be on display during the whole Meeting

POSTER PREPARATION

1. **Size of usable area: 90cm wide and 200 cm high (width x height).**
2. **The Title, the Author(s) and the Place(s) of work should be positioned at the top** of the poster.
3. Each presentation should include a brief explanation of the Aims, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
4. All text, tables, and drawings should be large enough to be seen at a distance of 2 m.
5. Drawings may be originals or photographs, provided they are of appropriate size.

Data should be in the form of tables and/or figures.

6. Only English language may be used.
7. The **presentation number of your poster** will be given to you at the registration desk.

This number will also be printed in the Provisional and Final Programme and **on the poster board.**

Thank you for your co-operation in making the poster exhibition visually attractive and intellectually exciting.
